

He along with the other panel members debated and discussed the implications of the New Pension Scheme (NPS) for government employees in the near future. As per the importance of the issue discussed, the programme was aired during the channel's Prime-Time slot.



- The Dept. of Philosophy called for a Parent-Teacher Meet on the 3rd of June, 2022 so as to encourage and facilitate better interaction amongst the parents and teachers of its The meeting was attended by the students. parents/guardians of 21 students of the department and there was a very fruitful exchange of thoughts and opinions regarding myriad things such as academic progress, ensuing sessional examination etc. The parents were very proactive in communicating their concerns and expectations and requested the department to hold such meetings at regular intervals for the overall benefit of the students.
- CAS promotion interviews from Stage I to Stage II and stage II to Stage III were also held for several teachers of the Commerce Stream on the same day. Dr. Prasanta Sarma was the Gauhati University VC nominee for the interviews of teachers belonging to the Accountancy, Finance and Management departments whereas Dr. Hemanta Kumar Das was the nominee for the interview process of teachers from the Mathematics department. So far as subject experts invited for conducting the interviews were concerned, Dr.Gour Gopal Banik was called for Accountancy, Dr. Bhababati Sarma for Management, Dr. Debabrata Sarma for Finance and Dr. Ajoy Kr. Das for Mathematics.



• 3rd of June being the World Bicycle Day, another activity that marked the day was the bicycle rally in which NSS volunteers of the college participated. The rally started from Khanapara field and ended at Barsapara Stadium, Guwahati.



- The Parent-Teacher Meet of the Philosophy department was followed by another such meet organized by the Department of Economics on the 4th of June. Around 34 parents/guardians attended the programme and shared their thoughts and valuable opinions with the department's faculties.
- 4th June also being the eve of the World Environment Day, the Dept. of BBA/BCA organized a Poster Making Competition with the theme "Only One Earth" to promote the message of environmental conservation. The competition saw the participation of a total of 43 students from across various departments of the college. Children of two faculty members also enthusiastically participated in the same.



• With the same objective of celebrating the eve of the World Environment Day, the Extension Activity Cell of the college too organized a plantation drive in which, following the recommendation of NASA, around 30 plants having air purifying qualities were planted. The planting was done in a well-planned manner so as to result in a garden for the college. Principal, Dr. Navajyoti Borah inaugurated the plantation programme and expressed his appreciation by proactively participating in the same and planting a tree himself. As part of the programme, the Extension Activity Cell also donated 620 jute bags bearing the college logo amongst shopkeepers as well as mobile pavement vendors of the Ganeshguri locality. Student representatives from the college spread the message of environmental protection and preservation by urging the traders to minimize and eventually altogether stop their use of single-use plastics.



• On the very same day, a talk on "Mental Health" was also jointly organized by the Department of Education and Political Science in collaboration with the Department of Psychiatry, District Hospital, Sonapur. The students were hugely benefitted from the insights offered by the speaker on different issues relating to the maintenance of a healthy mental equilibrium.

• NSS volunteers of the college observed the World Environment Day on the 5th of June, 2022 by participating in a programme organized by the Ministry of Youth Welfare & Sports. During the event, such issues as proper sanitary waste disposal system, plastic segregation and reduction of waste which are vital for a clean, hygienic and safe environment were discussed.



- On the occasion of the World Environment Day, the Innovation and Extension Cell of the college also organized a massive cleanliness drive incorporating not just members of the college fraternity but also all major stakeholders of the greater Ganeshguri area. Faculty members of the college, volunteers from the NCC and NSS wings, students including all office bearers of Dispur College Students' Union as well as representatives from Dispur Mahila Samiti, Kachari Basti Mahila Samiti, Dispur Sakha Mahila Santha and other office bearers of different organizations of the locality assembled in the playground of Gopal Boro School at 8.30 A.M. with all necessary tools and protective devices such as gloves and masks to participate in the drive. The members eventually dispersed into several sub-groups, with each group focused on cleaning a different part of the locality. Jute bags were also distributed and local vendors encouraged to abstain from circulating single-use plastics/plastic bags.
- The drive was preceded by a formal inaugural session in the college auditorium during which Principal, Dr. Navajyoti Borah stressed upon Dispur college's vision for a healthy, happy, and sustainable environment, noting that the cleanliness drive was a small but significant step in that direction.



- The seven-days long annual college week, 2022 started with great fun and fiesta from the 6th of June. The week-long programme started off with a ceremonial cultural rally in which students from all the departments of the college participated. With each department representing uniquely different facets of the country's culture, the rally was an amalgamation of themes that upheld the rich heritage and diversity of India. Veteran actress, Nikumoni Saikia inaugurated the rally at 11 AM which took off from the college campus to a distance of around 1 km in the Ganeshguri area. At the end of the rally, the Department of Finance which had showcased episodes from the Ramayana was declared as the winning team and was awarded with a cash prize of Rs. 5000.
- Several competitions were held under different categories such as Major Games, Minor Games, Cultural Section, Literary Section, Debate and Symposium Section as well as Fine Arts section during the course of the college week so as to offer students a plethora of events wherein to display and hone their talents. The most awaited events, the contests for the titles of Miss and Mr. Dispur, 2022 took place on the 11th of June at the college auditorium in the presence of a huge gathering of students. The coveted titles were bagged by Chiyasmi Chetia, a second semester student of the English department and Aftabur Rahman, a student of B.Com. 2nd semester respectively.
- The fun-filled week came to an end on the 13th of June with a Valedictory Programme to felicitate the winners as well as to encourage and motivate other students to participate in such co-curricular activities. Veteran singer Shanta Uzir was invited as the special Guest of Honour for the ceremony.



Parallel to the College Week, other activities were also being carried out with equal fervor in the college. A Three-days' Workshop on 'Yoga and Meditation' was initiated jointly by the NSS unit and the Yoga and Meditation Cell of the college from the 8th of June. Parijat Lahkar and Anil Saikia, both Yoga Instructors from the Siddhi Yoga Centre, were invited to train participants on different techniques of this age-old Indian tradition. A total of 48 students, including NCC cadets and NSS volunteers, joined the workshop where they not only practiced the different postures of yoga and the various techniques of meditation and 'Kriya' but also learned about their numerous benefits.



Alongside the inauguration of the three-days long workshop, another inaugural activity that took place on the day was the opening of a new issue of "Saraswat"—the wall magazine of the Assamese Department. Dr. Namita Deka, a retired faculty member from the college who had also formerly headed the department, was invited as a special Guest of Honour for the purpose. The theme of this new issue was 'War and Peace' and students contributed many articles, poems, slogans, paintings and photographs that reflected their thoughts on the futility of war and the necessity of peace and harmony.



 The same day, Vice Principal, Dr.Sunita Agawalla was also invited as a Resource Person by Dudhnoi College, Goalpara, Assam. In the programme organized by the IQAC of the college, she delivered a very thought-provoking lecture on the topic "Learning to Say NO".



• On 9th June, Principal, Dr. Navajyoti Borah attended the 37th Biennial Conference of the Assam College Principals' Council (ACPC) at Dikhowmukh College, Sivasagar, Assam. During the conference, he was selected as the Assistant Joint Secretary of the ACPC for the current session.



• Two faculty members from the Political Science Department—Mrs. Dharitri Thakuria (HoD) and Dr. Shikha Jyoti Deka—presented their papers in a two-days National Seminar on "Contemporary Issues of Politics and International Relations" held at University of Science and Technology, Meghalaya (USTM) on the 13th and 14th of June. They were accompanied by 15 students of their department who also actively participated in the seminar. The Seminar was organized by USTM in collaboration with Dispur College and Karmashri Hiteswar Saikia College, Guwahati.



• On the 15th of June, the birth anniversary of renowned Assamese litterateur, Dr Lakshminandan Bora, Dispur College was fortunate to be the recipient of a collection of many of his invaluable books. In loving memory of the great writer and intellectual, his family had donated some of his treasured and timeless creations to the Dispur College Library with the hope and belief that the books would inspire and enlighten many of the young readers of the college. The donation took place in a ceremony organized at the Sudmersen Hall of Cotton University. • On the 18th of June, faculty members from the BBA Department, Ms. Pallavi Kashyap and Ms. Rashmi Barman attended the Faculty Academic Enrichment Programme organized by SAI University at Hotel Gateway Grandeur, Guwahati. The programme emphasized on updating and educating teachers on the requirements of the current education scenario and focused on such topics as the new model of international education, role of law in environmental protection and conservation, interdisciplinary approach in Higher Education etc.



- To mark the death anniversary of Kalaguru Bishnu Prasad Rabha on the 20th of June, 2022, the State, National and International Festival Celebration Committee of the college in association with Reliance Jewels organized a programme that lovingly commemorated and honoured the legendary musical maestro and social worker who transformed Assamese society with his music. The programme began with prayers and floral tributes followed by an inaugural speech by Principal, Dr. Navajyoti Borah. Retired faculty member, Dr. Rani M. Deka, who had also served as the Vice Principal of the college, was invited as the special guest for the occasion. Dr. Deka delivered a talk on Kalaguru wherein she presented a brief trajectory of his life and some of his most important works. The programme was also rendered lively by the performance of Rabha Sangeet by different faculty members, other staff and students of the college.
- The same day, a three-days long 'Finishing School Programme' was also initiated at Dispur College by Gauhati Commerce College under the Equity Initiative Programme of RUSA, Govt. of Assam.
