

Is Twinkle a critic when it comes to your style choices?



Badshah drops grudge against Yo Yo Honey Singh

D rake and Kendrick Lamar may have just started, but it seems that after years of friction, Badshah is ready to end his feud with fellow rapper Yo Yo Honey Singh. In a surprising move, he seemingly took the first step to end their long-standing tiff, during GraFest 2024, held in Dehradun (Uttarakhand) recently.

In a viral video, he could be seen halting his performance midway and saying, "There was a phase in my life where I held this grudge, and now, I want to call it quits and leave that grudge behind — and that's Honey Singh. I was unhappy because of some misunderstandings but then I realised when we were together, jodne waale bahut kam thay, todne waale bahut thay. Today I just want to let everyone know I've left that phase behind and I wish him all the best."

It all started first in 2009 when the duo parted ways from the hip-hop group Mafia Mundeer. Since then, tension has simmered, with barbs exchanged in music and on social media.

I DON'T PERFORM AT WEDDINGS: PAPON

The singer says he only likes to sing for an audience 'whose priority is music'

After a recent disagreement between singers Abhijeet Bhattacharya and Neha Kakkar on a reality show over singers performing at weddings, a lot of musicians shared their views on the same. While most of them saw no harm in performing at weddings, some had a different view. Singer Papon, who does live shows and events, says he doesn't perform at weddings. "People go to weddings for a different purpose. The idea is to have fun, meet people, enjoy themselves, have food, etc. Music is not the focus there. Hence, I don't perform at weddings. I like to sing for an audience that treats music as their priority, be it a concert or baithak," says the singer.

While live shows give a lot of creative satisfaction to artistes, of late, there have been instances of unruly audience members manhandling musicians — be it hurling a water bottle on stage at a recent Sunidhi Chauhan show or last year's instances of Sonu Nigam and Kailash Kher being troubled by concertgoers.

Commenting on this, Papon says, "Of course it hurts because people forget that the performer on stage is a human being too. But I've always received so much love from the audience that even if one person misbehaved, I let such a one-off instance pass. The purpose of being an artiste is greater than such unpleasant incidents. Being a musician and being able to spread so much joy and happiness is a bigger cause for me."

On the work front, the singer, known for tracks such as *Jiyein Kyun (Dum Maaro Dum, 2011)* and *Kyun (Barfi!, 2012)*, has a lot of projects lined up, including a ghazal. "As musicians, we know how to make music, but releasing it is a task. I am sitting on a lot of film and non-film songs that I'd release soon," he ends.

PAPON, Singer

Ikka's focus more on 'legit' songs, not viral

For Ikka, making music for his satisfaction is a priority, numbers come second. At a time when number of views a song gets online is a metric for its popularity, the rapper, who is all set to launch his new album, feels his tracks "should feel legit" instead of just being viral.

Known for hits such as *Badri Ki Dulhania (Badrinath Ki Dulhania, 2017)* and *Dilbar (Satyameva Jayate, 2018)*, Ikka says, "Har artiste chahta hai numbers aayein, aisa gaana banaun jo viral ho. But I also feel that I have followed the path where I felt [creatively] satisfied. If a song is good, numbers will come in automatically. Numbers are not the first priority. I have seen a lot of songs [that didn't deserve to do well]... Kisi bhi cheez pe views aa jaate hain aaj kal. Mera gaana aisa hona chahiye ki log sunke legit bolein."

Having said that, the rapper finds nothing wrong if an artiste wants to

only make massy music, for the sake of views. "Main toh dono kar raha hoon — massy bhi, experimental bhi. Massy music se apne kharche, bill, rent nikalta hoon. Tupac bhi karta tha (late rapper). Drake is the biggest name today in the rapping world and he, too, does both massy and underground music. An artiste should go beyond boundaries. At least koshish toh karoon," he asserts.

Ask how does he deal with the pressure from music labels, who look at it from a business point of view, and Ikka replies, "Mujhe aisa koi label nahin mila jisne mujhe pressurise kiya ho. I have made it evident that main jo sochunga, woh karunga. The labels I worked with let me do my thing respectfully. I am very happy working with them."

Shanthi Priya finds work 'more professional now' than the '90s

Shanthi Priya, who became a known face on the silver screen after *Saugandh (1991)*, asserts that things have changed for the better from then to now.


The actor tells us, "Earlier, we never had monitors on the sets, no reading or practice sessions, dialogues were given instantly, and there were no action rehearsals during film shoots. But now, pre- and post-production patterns have changed drastically. It used to take six-eight months, and poor film ban jata tha. Today things are planned from scratch, be it casting, location, costumes and others."

The actor discovered the evolution when she worked on the web series *Dharavi Bank*. "Costumes were fixed as per light and the mood palette of the scene. Back in the '90s, we had two-to-three dull sarees for regular scenes and heavy ones for songs. If the stylist felt our saree was too dull or bright, as per requirement, they used to buy extra from the market. Now things are done more professionally, with each department being well prepared. It's a pleasant surprise," she adds.

Priya calls it unbelievable how fast the clock has ticked since starring in massy hits of the decade, such as *Phool Aur Angaar (1993)*. "It was after doing regional films for a couple of years that I got this

Hindi film with a beautifully written character of Chand."

While many think the actor was on a break from work, Priya says it was "a matter of on and off work". "It was never a hiatus. After getting married in 1992, I was busy with family. In 2002, I was offered the TV daily soap *Aryaman*, followed by the mythological show *Mata Ki Chowki* in 2008, which went on for three years. So, I never left the Hindi industry," shares the actor, adding, "In fact, it was South Indian language films that I left. Now, after 33 years, I am making a comeback with filmmaker Vetrimaaran's next, which is a biopic based on a freedom fighter. I will also be doing a Hindi web show."

Ayesha Singh's fans were shocked when a picture of her swollen face surfaced on social media. In a post on May 19, the actor shared a photo showing her swelling on the left side and wrote: "I've been a little down on health, but I'm trying to recover and resume with all the updates, super soon."

Detailing the incident, Singh tells us that she was at home with family when her face started puffing up. "We got it checked, but there was no accurate diagnosis. Gradually, the pain increased, and I couldn't talk. When half of my face swelled up and the pain became intolerable we got worried. We thought it could be something major."



Despite consulting two medical experts, the 27-year-old hasn't found relief. "I have connected with a third doctor, but we still can't pinpoint the root cause of the swelling. He suggested treating it as an infection for now. It's been a while, but the pain hasn't changed much," shares the actor,



who played the lead in *Ghum Hai Kisikey Pyaar Mein*, adding that the duration of her ordeal has been too long.

She admits that the swelling on her face has been concerning as an actor. However, her doctor assured her that there wouldn't be "any marks left after recovery or any such concerns". "I am optimistic. The doctor is confident of recovery, so I'm keeping my fingers crossed," she ends.

I am grateful that I got to do something so pure and organic," says the composer-singer.

Sharing why he is "hugely involved in devotional music", the musician says, "It's the kind of music I resonate with. I like the energy it instills in me. 





From absolutely rocking unbuttoned dungarees in the '90s to flaunting pink pants on the most serious occasions, Akshay Kumar has always been a trendsetter. We chatted the actor up on his fashion choices, channelling stress to look great from the inside out, and more. Excerpts:

Very few can rock pink the way you do. Thoughts on men wearing pink?

I love pink — especially baby pink. For some of my favourite looks and moments in life, I was wearing pink. Well, I even interviewed the Prime Minister of India while wearing pink pants! 





Fire, fire, everywhere?

The fire department receives several emergency calls every day. "Out of every 100 calls we get, about 55 to 60 are cases of fire and the rest are emergencies of other nature. Of those 55 to 60, about 50% of the fires are due to electricity," informs Tomar.

OVERLOAD
In the hot months, high power usage leads to overload. "People are keeping their ACs on all day and plugging too many devices in the same sockets. Mostly, the wiring isn't equipped to handle this and starts to melt because of the high amount of current. Situations like these end up causing a short-circuit," says electrician Mohd Saleem.



NEGLIGENCE
"A lot of times people buy non-ISI-marked equipment. Sirf thode se paise bachane ke liye cheap options le aate hain aur phir baad mein aag ka khatra bana rehta hai," says Yusuf Khan, an electrician, adding, "Sometimes when the wiring isn't properly insulated and the voltage is high, tab bhi bijli se aag lag jati hai. This is what is referred to as a short circuit."

MISUSE
Misuse and overload of electrical appliances contribute to fire hazards. "People install ACs in smaller sockets or use incorrect Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs), causing higher current flow than the device can handle. This leads to AC fires," informs Tomar. Additionally, overuse of ACs and plugging multiple devices into one socket can cause wiring meltdown and short circuits.

Delhi experienced a record power demand at 8,000MW on Wednesday—the highest in the city's history. On the same day, the Capital reported several incidents of fire, reflecting the challenges residents face due to the intense heat. According to official statistics from the Delhi Fire Services (DFS), the number of fire calls in the first 20 days of May alone has more than doubled compared to last year, reaching 2,280. "The rise in fire incidents this year can be attributed to two main factors: the high heat and dryness in the air, and the overload, negligence, or misuse of electricity," explains Sanjay Tomar, deputy director of DFS. Feeling the heat? Here's what you need to watch out for.

AC troubleshooting

Electricians report a surge in calls for AC repair and servicing this summer. "I visit 40 to 50 homes a day. People complain that their ACs aren't cooling properly, assuming it's a gas leak or filter breakage. But most ACs are actually functioning fine! With temperatures above 45 degrees outside, expecting 18 degrees inside is unrealistic," says Mohd Saleem.

ENSURE YOUR AC IS FUNCTIONING PROPERLY; ELECTRICIANS' TIP-OFF

- Regular AC servicing prevents voltage fluctuations.
- Avoid splashing water on the AC unit while cleaning.
- Don't run your AC all day. Use timers to regulate usage, especially at night.
- Ensure MCBs are regularly checked for current leakage.
- Clean AC filters frequently and maintain proper ventilation for outdoor units.
- Keep sunlight out with curtains to maintain indoor coolness.
- Rearrange furniture to allow proper airflow from AC vents.

DOCTORS SPEAK
"Electrical burn injuries cause more damage than is visible to the eye," informs Dr Raja Tiwari, additional professor, Plastic Surgery, AIIMS. "In the last month, our department has seen over 17 cases of electrical contact burns," he adds. While first aid for most burns involves cooling the area under running water, Dr Tiwari cautions that it might cause more harm in high-tension electrical burns due to the exposure of deeper tissues.

Golfer Diksha Dagar: I'm not comfortable being called a para-athlete

Athlete Diksha Dagar's name is now synonymous with golf, but few realise that she wields a pen as effortlessly as she does a golf club to tee-off. The second-year BCom (Prog) student at Delhi University's (DU) School of Open Learning (SOL) recently tied for the 24th position in the 2024 Amundi German Masters. Despite her accolades, Dagar expresses discomfort with being labelled a paralympian. "I am not so comfortable being called a para-athlete," says the 23-year-old who was conferred the Arjuna Award this January. She also recently made history as the first Indian golfer to compete in 100 tournaments on the Ladies European Tour (LET) and is currently on another international tour, striving to bring more laurels to her country. With such impressive feats, the athlete feels strongly about being pigeonholed. Born with profound deafness, Dagar relies primarily on lip-reading or sign language to communicate. "I

don't think any athlete wants to be referred to [as disabled]. It's like being labelled as someone lesser and being put in a box. But there is no other option, and there seems to be no other way (to compete)," she asserts.

Despite this, she refuses to let her disability hinder her commitment to the sport, making her the only golfer to participate in both the Olympics and the Deaflympics, where she has


won two medals. "The biggest challenge [as a hearing-impaired person] is when people have different accents, especially on international tours. But overcoming that is as important for me as excelling in my discipline," she explains.

Reflecting on her student life, which is often overshadowed by consecutive tournaments, Dagar calls SOL an "inclusive space" for differently-abled athletes. "When I'm at DU, I feel there are opportunities available to us," says the Haryana-born Army kid. "We're the selected few, so we're better off than most physically challenged people in other parts of the country. I'm trying to make the most of it... Being a professional athlete, my academics often take a backseat. But it's a well-deliberated decision. That's where an institution like SOL is helpful; it's why I can play 100 LET tournaments," she says, adding, "However, there is a need for athlete-specific courses in DU to ensure inclusivity for athletes who don't want their academics to suffer."



'DELHI WAS THE FIRST BIG CITY I EVER SAW AND I FELL IN LOVE WITH IT'

Actor Navneet Malik reflects on the pivotal role Delhi played in shaping his career and his perspective on life



Delhi has given me a lot. If this city was not near my hometown Rohtak, it might not have been so easy for me to reach where I am today.

Though some social media posts have dubbed Delhi as "boring," actor Navneet Malik believes the city will always remain "dilwallon ki." The actor, who was in the city after wrapping up filming for *The Virgin Tree*—a horror-comedy which also stars actors Sanjay Dutt, Sunny Singh and Mouni Roy—tells us that his love affair with the Capital began in 2013 when he landed here from his hometown Rohtak (Haryana) for a civil engineering job. "Rohtak ke baad, pehli baar I saw a city this big and I fell in love with it. It felt like I could build a future here," says the actor, known for his roles in OTT films like *Love Hostel*, *Heropanti 2* (both 2022) and *The Freelancer* (2023).

In his early days, Malik would scour online calls for models and actors and frequented Hauz Khas Village (HKV) to stand in line to audition with hundreds of other hopefuls. "I was thinking

in terms of holding a job in the big city, but I pushed myself to reach somewhere that I could see the bigger perspective. Gaon se nikalkar sheher mein aaya, tab socha tha ki jo karna hai yahin [Delhi mein] karna hai," recalls the 30-year-old. "I never had guidance; it was a learning phase when I came here... I got comfortable in front of the camera in HKV," he says, sitting beside the reservoir in the same location. For Malik, the fort, lake and Deer Park were places that were "mysteries" that remained unexplored. "I always came here for auditions and to eat at the fast food joints. But if I wanted to explore, I would go to Old Delhi," he reveals and continues, "If this city was not near my hometown, it might not have been easy for me to reach where I am today."

Crediting the city for giving broadening his perspectives, Malik recalls an incident that is etched in his memory: "Once, near Jama Masjid I met a bunch of foreigners and struck up a conversation. English aache se aati nahi thi, par tooti phooti bhasha mein kuch

toh maine kaha tha. Main poore time unke saath raha since sab foreigner dekh kar unse zyada paise le rahe thay. Bahut kuch seekhne ko milta hai Delhi mein. Yahin se travel ka chaska laga, personality bani, aur culture bhi seekha. Whenever I visit, I learn something new here!"




