Indian musician Diljit Dosanjh, who is currently on his music tour across North America, recently made his debut appearance on *The Tonight Show Starring Jimmy Fallon*. Introduced by the host as 'the biggest Punjabi artiste on the planet', Dosanjh went on to perform his hit tracks *G.O.A.T* and *Born To Shine* for the live audience, while also showing some Bhangra moves.

The 40-year-old was dressed

in traditional Punjabi attire, complete with a matching turban and a pleated fan. He even sang his latest track *Main Hoon Punjab* from his recent film *Amar Singh Chamkila*, while tweaking a few lines of *G.O.A.T* to *Hollywood Vich Jine Stars Hai Unade Vich Baitha Sardar Goriye*, as he pointed to Fallon.

Dosanjh also shared some BTS moments with Fallon on Instagram, where the duo was seen having a

fun exchange. Dosanjh was seen teaching Punjabi to the American host. Dosanjh made Fallon say his signature phrases 'Punjabi aa gaye oye' and 'Sat Sri Akaal'.

The video left several actors impressed. Actor Priyanka Chopra Jonas commented, "It's the Oye for me." Prior to this, Dosanjh made history by becoming the first Punjabi artiste to perform at the Coachella Valley Music and Arts Festival in the US, last year.

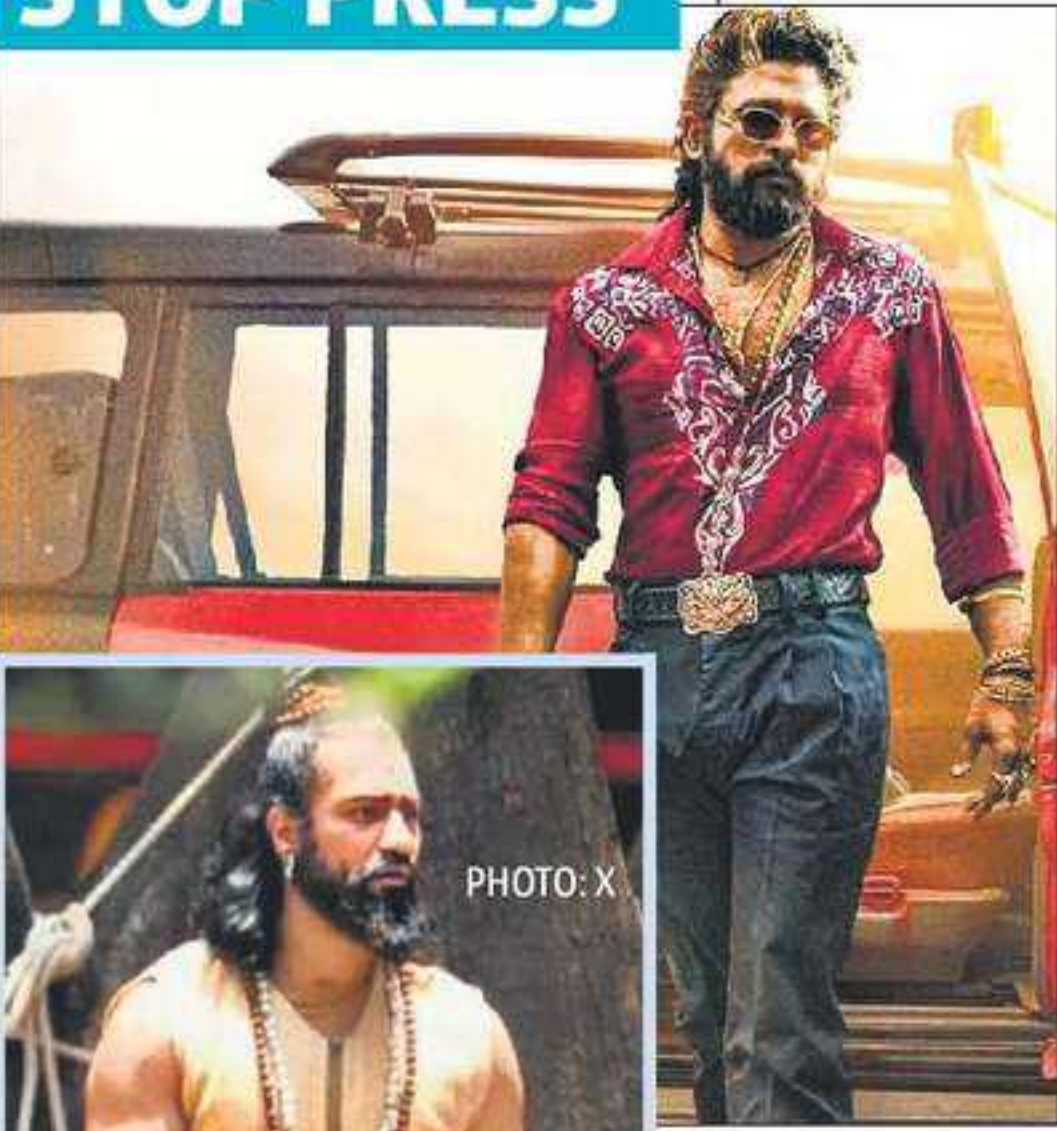

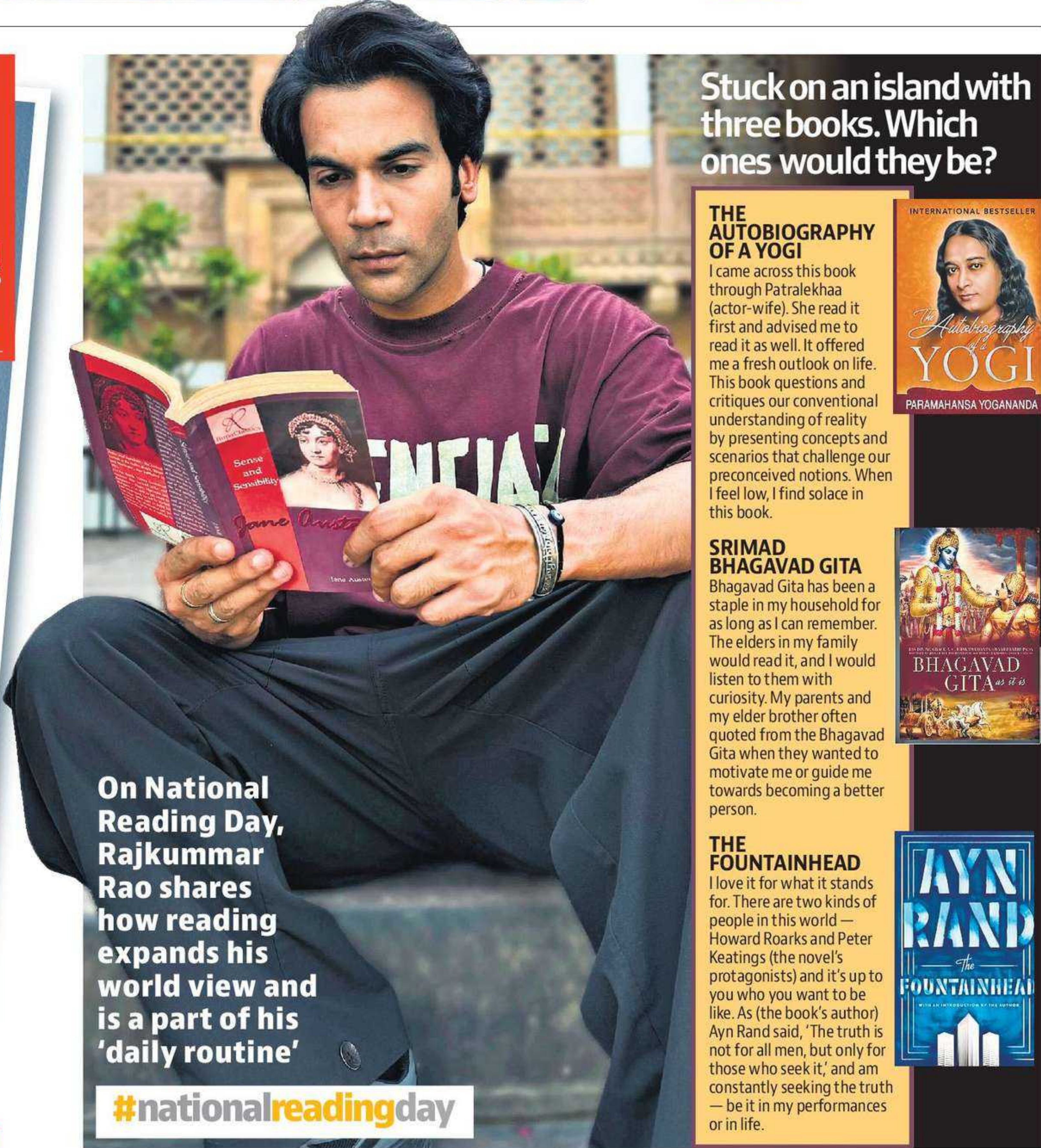

Addressing her friends, she revealed why she's been 'missing in action', as her last Insta post was on Mother's Day in May. "A few weeks ago, as I walked out of a flight, I suddenly felt I was not able to hear anything... I want to

break my silence now for all my friends and well-wishers who have been asking me why I'm missing in action. It has been diagnosed by me docs as a rare sensorineural nerve hearing loss, due to a viral attack," the 58-year-old wrote.

She added, "I would add a word of caution regarding exposure to loud music and headphones. One day, I wish to share the health perils of my professional life."

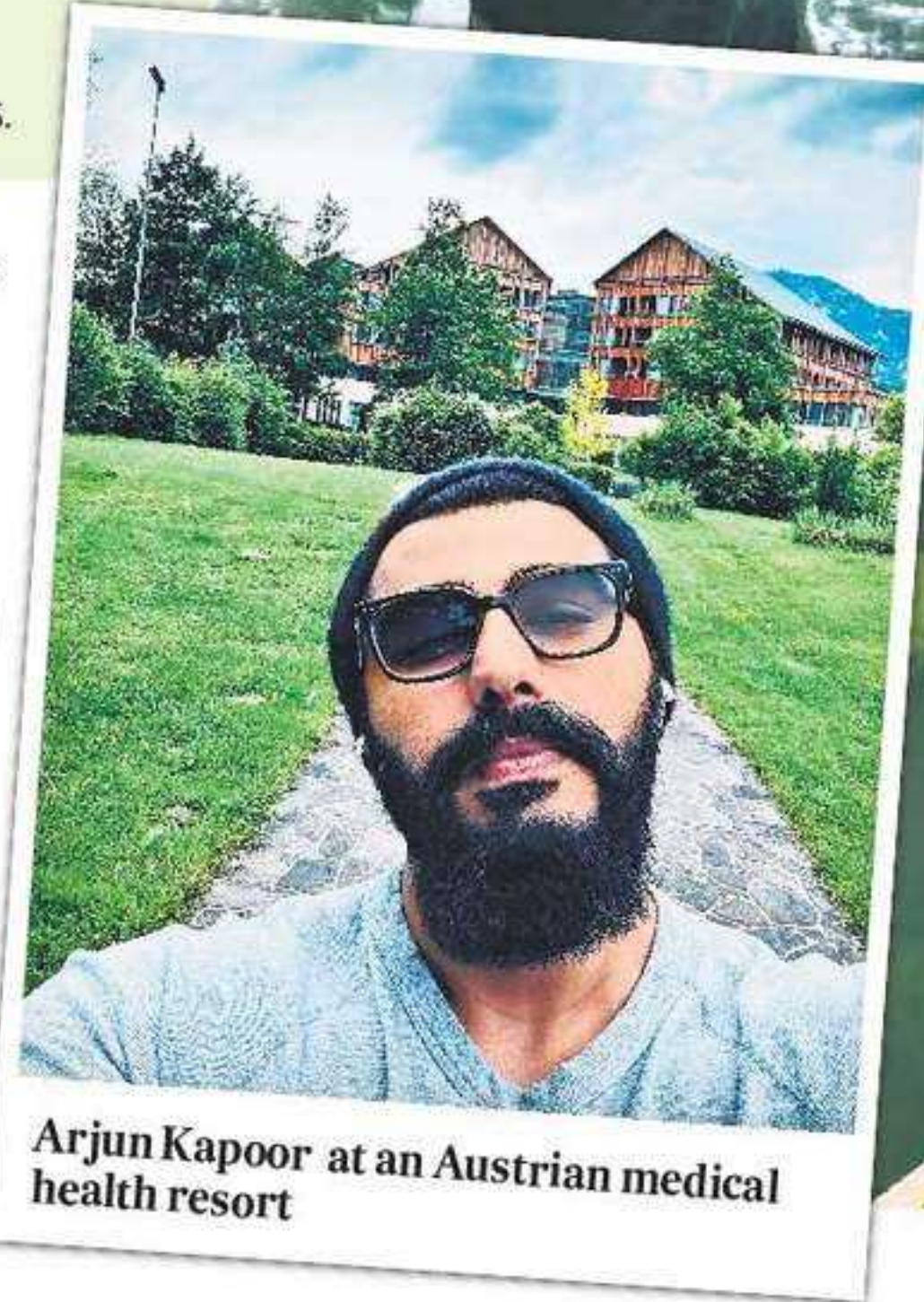
As we observe World Sauntering Day today, which calls on people to slow down, we have rounded up destination retreats from across India for a psychological, physical and spiritual getaway.

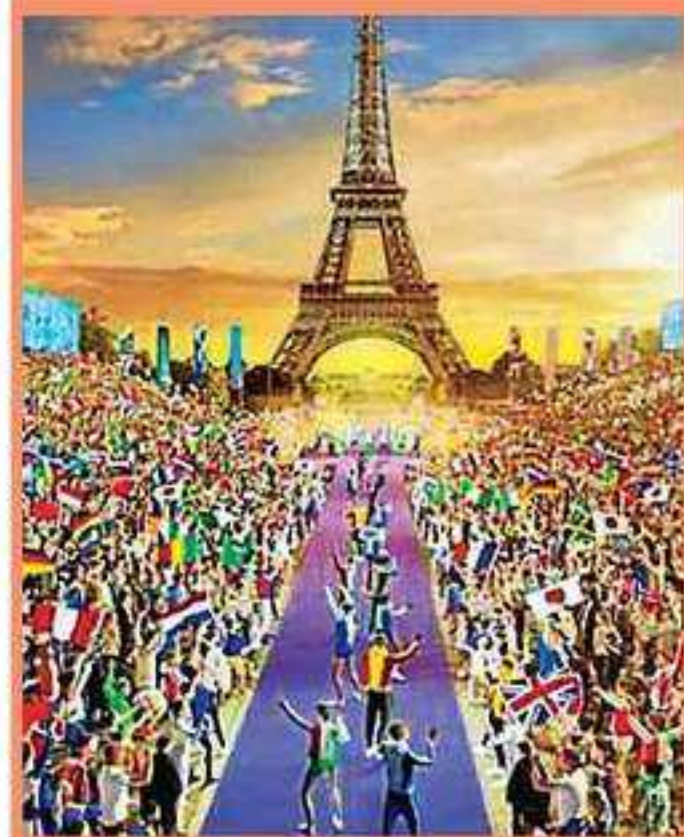

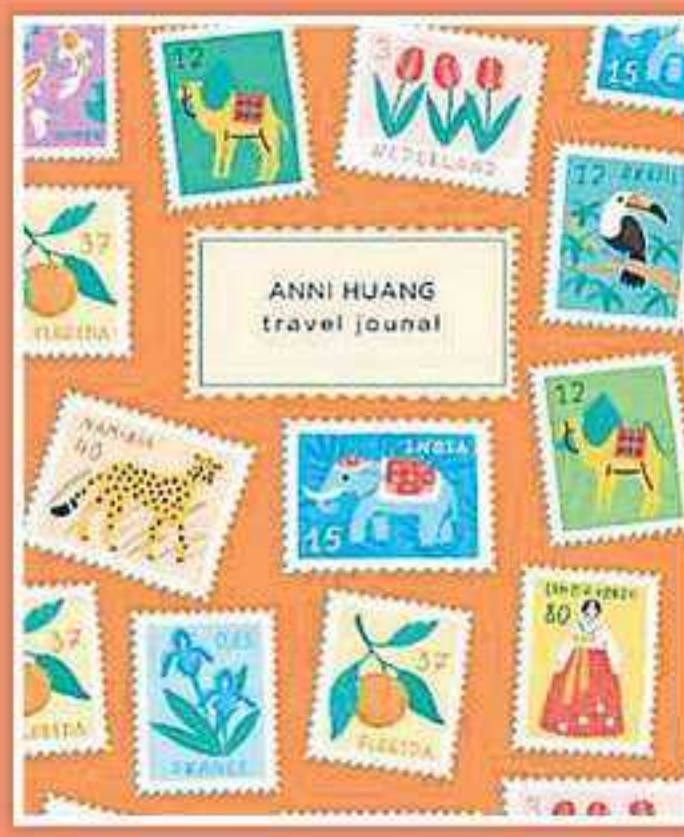
INDIAN FLYERS HOT ON SPORTS

After much speculation around their wedding, actor-couple Sonakshi Sinha and Zaheer Iqbal are set to tie the knot on June 23. And it looks like the festivities have already begun. On Monday night, Sinha shared several pictures on Instagram from what seems to be a bachelorette party. The snaps featured her bestie, actor Huma Qureshi and Iqbal's sister, stylist Sanam Ratansi.

Now, we have learnt that the couple will host a haldi ceremony on June 20, three days before their wedding. "The function will take place at Sonakshi's new Bandra (Mumbai) home, which she bought after leaving her parents' house. It will be a tight setting with only close friends and family. Less than 50 people have been invited for the function — that's why they opted for Sona's house as the venue," says a source.

Out of context: Sharmin on 'negative' interviews

Actor Sharmin Segal has been on the receiving end of heavy criticism for her performance in Sanjay Leela Bhansali's web series, *Heeramandi: The Diamond Bazaar* and her "negative" interviews.

Segal has been facing flak for what many consider to be dismissive remarks about her co-stars; in a now-viral video, the actor seemed to refer to her co-star Sanjeeda Shaikh as an "outsider". During the interview, Shaikh called Bhansali a "perfectionist", to
