





STYLE DIARY: KITCHENS

THREE DESIGNERS CREATE SHOWSTOPPING KITCHENS THAT ARE REPLETE WITH LUXURY DETAILS AND PREMIUM FUNCTIONALITY.

We never get tired of talking about kitchens, and with good reason: commonly acknowledged as the hub space of the home, form and function must peacefully coexist. The best kitchens are timeless in design, but include technology and materials that make life simpler and more enjoyable.

Kitchens provide space for families to gather for meals, to cook together, do homework, and catch up with the events of the day. But they also require ample storage, appliances that do some heavy lifting, and durable, easy-to-maintain surfaces. Here, we explore three kitchens, and highlight some of the things that make them special. ■



In the jewel-toned wet bar, a **Sub-Zero** beverage cooler is a must. At the kitchen island, leggy **Powell & Bonnell** Contralto stools from **deAurora** are covered in gray leather.



Steve Kadlec and Donna Corbat of Kadlec Architecture + Design created this kitchen and wet bar for a couple in Lincoln Park with three children. They removed walls to open the plan and create a large kitchen, new butler's pantry, and family room space. A light and natural finish palette of white oak and bluestone flooring, and crisp white walls serve as a casual backdrop for both formal and informal spaces, creating a family-focused, livable environment that belies its urban location. In the wet bar, dark and moody colors add to the ambiance.

When Dan Rak's client purchased this house in Northfield, Illinois, it was, according to Rak, "very much modern farmhouse, and they hated it." He continues, "Their personal style is pretty contemporary, so we were challenged to take the architecture and interiors in a more modern direction. The cabinets in this kitchen were beautiful and of great quality, so we wanted to work with them. We focused our efforts on the areas above the countertop to add some edge and some much needed contrast." Rak and his team created a custom hood and concave tiles for the backsplash, adding graphic elements such as the Karam pendants from **Visual Comfort**, through **CAI Designs**.

Kurth says that they needed new cabinetry to replace what was damaged in the flood, and they wanted a showstopping island with a sensational slab of stone. They also wanted a desk space that was tucked away, and increased pantry space and storage. The design team accomplished all of that and more, adding a feeding station for the family pup, as well as a multifunctional desk space/household command center and butler's pantry that keeps the family organized and ready for entertaining. Besides being a showplace, the kitchen provides ultimate functionality with appliances by **Sub-Zero, Wolf, and Bosch. The Galley** Workstation sink and **Brizo's** Litze fixtures make prep and cleanup a breeze. The backsplash is **Porcelanosa's** Gravity Aluminum 3D Hexagon Gold tile.



Wallpaper is a brilliant way to add drama and interest in the bath or powder room. Graphic or tropical patterns have a mural effect, and can enhance a room that can frequently has unusual proportions or a lack of natural light. Even small powder rooms can be transformed with skillful selection and application of the correct materials. When it comes to the bath,

it's important to choose materials like vinyl or treated paper that can withstand water and steam, but in a powder room there are no restrictions. Barbara Sallick, author and co-founder of Waterworks says, "I can't think of a better place to experiment with some funky wall covering than a small bath. The drama ratio is high and the expense can be low because so little material is needed." Get inspired with our portfolio of glamorous baths. ■

She says, "We decided to have a barn-door-style mirror custom-made to cover the windows. It allows privacy when necessary and light when that is preferred. 

Classic homes never go out of style, but keeping a classic home stylish takes some doing. Sticking to tradition is one way to go about it. But for John Cialone, vice president at Tom Stringer Design Partners, tweaking the expected was the way to go when it came to helping a client update a brick Georgian in Highland Park.

The client, who had worked previously with the Stringer office on his city residence, gave Cialone and his team carte blanche to make the home work for him, and look great while doing it. “The client loved our process for the in-town project, and he let us run with it here once the team was built,” relates Cialone. “He had specific ideas

that we incorporated, but he always allowed us to think outside of the box.”

The initial, motivating goal was to improve the layout and flow, making the house suitable for entertaining while also creating cozy areas for the homeowner to enjoy daily. Cialone reconfigured the kitchen to meet today’s notion of that all-important space by removing an unused back stair and incorporating a once separate breakfast room to produce a large, inviting environment for serious cooking and great gatherings. He reconfigured the guest bathrooms, the primary bathroom and dressing room, and introduced several built-ins in here and there as an homage to the home’s original style. “And the mechanical systems and

lighting were improved throughout,” notes Cialone, “as the house needed the layers and options of both recessed lighting and decorative fixtures in every space. I knew fixing the backgrounds and the architecture was key for the success of the decoration that followed.”

When it came to fleshing out the home with furniture, window treatments and accessories, Cialone’s design scheme gave a good nod to the traditional while incorporating pieces that sport a leaner, more minimal look. “I love traditional interiors, but I am very conscious of them feeling stale or tired,” shares Cialone. “So we mixed in clean-lined pieces based on traditional designs. We also layered in pieces from the client’s collection. Each room has a blend of old and new. For example, in the living room, a new custom sofa from O. Henry House is flanked by a set of wood-stained nesting tables from the client’s collection. I also love high-low design and there are many pieces that I might consider extravagant—such as the

Baker Furniture Chinese Chippendale cabinet in the living room—but there are also items that give the house a feeling of not taking itself too seriously that includes accessories picked up at local vintage stores.”

Cialone’s past-and-present approach makes for subtle, engaging contrasts, such as that between the richly-hued, dramatically patterned rug and mirrored coffee table in the living room. Equally eye-catching is the play of colors throughout the house, from the banquette-lined breakfast nook, where shades of blue and green echo the hues of nature right outside the bay window, to the hunter green of the bar that adjoins the basement entertaining area. Balancing the guest-welcoming appeal of the home’s public spaces is the comforting attention Cialone devoted to its private areas, most notably, the primary bedroom dressing room, which is generously appointed with handsome cabinetry, leather-clad walls, and a seating area set with a chaise lounge and a good reading lamp.

“We loved the bones of the house, and we were determined to build on its original character,” says Cialone. And he has. Sober—in the best way—yet refreshingly alive, these interiors possess a gravitas spun through with good spirits. Whether company is coming or not, this is a sweet place to call home. ■

Breegan Jane

A firm believer in “taking all the meetings,” designer, author, TV personality, and philanthropist Breegan Jane found herself sitting, slightly clueless, at a table with six women brand heads from Clarke & Clarke and Sanderson Design Group, its parent company. “I wasn't even sure who was going to be there,” says Breegan Jane. “But it immediately became apparent that the brands had some incredibly strong, passionate women at the helm. So, when they brought forth the idea of a brand partnership, I could see that my voice was going to be heard. That gave me confidence—because as my career has developed, I've realized that partnerships must feel organic and naturally connected. My brand is all about women empowerment, it was kismet.”

To start, Breegan Jane hit Sanderson Design Group's hundreds-of-years-old archives. “I love the storytelling aspect behind them all,” she explains. “You can pull out any collection, even just from 75 years ago and, based on the textile, pinpoint exactly where we were in humanity at that moment and what our values were. So, I see patternmaking as our version of leaving hieroglyphics behind for the future,” she adds.

The Clarke & Clarke x Breegan Jane collection—available exclusively through Kravet—consists of eight aspirational wallpapers and ten stunning fabrics—all printed on FSC-certified substrates and sourced sustainably. “I looked at the future differently once I became a parent and saw how our actions affect our world,” Breegan Jane explains. The vibrant collection is inspired by nature, the designer's travels, and her activist work in Kenya. “I'm a maximalist, and I live life by balancing things out—and by that, I mean I add to my plate, and give 100 percent to each important moment.”

Jennifer Manners

When London-based designer Jennifer Manners was tapped by luxury furnishings brand Sanderson to design a rug collection using her proprietary /re/Purpose Performance fibers (which are composed of recycled water bottles)—she was thrilled. “Lisa Montague was Sanderson’s new CEO, and she had a real drive to take the brand into a much more sustainably focused set of objectives right from the start. She came from fashion—an industry that seems to drive sustainability from a luxury angle faster than the interiors world,” explains Manners. While the designer delightedly accepted, she first had to get the “fiber up to a level that merits the investment of a handmade product.”

Hand-knotted in the Tibetan style, Manners’ eye-catching Fan Palm rug for **Sanderson** was inspired by one of the brand’s archival wallpapers. “It really resonated with me that they have all these classic patterns in their arsenal—they’re iconic and they feel intuitive to the environment in which they were created,” says Manners. “Also, after years of everything being beige and grayish, I was excited to use color in a way that’s happy without being overpowering.”

Once achieved, its incredible performance attributes were also realized—an unexpected yet positive surprise. Next came narrowing down the classic patterns she wanted to reinterpret. “I was hugely impressed by Sanderson,” says Manners. “Not just because it’s an 1860 heritage company (their archives contain wallpapers that are hundreds of years old!), but because they were so open to everything. I thought they were going to be so tough with what we can interpret and how we can interpret it, but they were just focused on creating beautiful rugs.” What resulted was Icon—a collection of five of Sanderson’s most quintessential patterns, including a damask, botanical prints, an ikat, and classic small-scale patterns reinterpreted with a contemporary twist (and with Manners’ eco-friendly fibers). A former foreign news journalist, Manners equates her previous career to design storytelling. “I also just love the idea that hundreds of years later, these patterns that were created by women (ikats, especially) are still being used—that’s a testament to classic design.”

Paola Navone



“The beginning of any collaboration is always enchanting,” says Italian architect Paola Navone, founder and creative visionary of the multidisciplinary design firm, OTTO Studio. “It can be the attraction to a place, a story, or a craft tradition—something that tickles our imagination. Without that alchemy, it’s difficult for a project to come to life,” she continues. A chemistry-filled collaboration between Navone, her firm, and iconic furnishings brand Baker Furniture, resulted in the Paola Navone Collection—a European-style grouping of 24 striking designs varying from tables, to seating, and lighting, with each product category named after an iconic Italian attraction. Each individual piece features soft lines countered with powerful materials such as cast bronze, Murano glass, acrylic, and Carrara C marble—that simultaneously pay homage to Italian manufacturing traditions and the exceptional craftsmanship Baker’s heritage commands. While the romanticized Mediterranean lifestyle and the relaxed informality and spontaneity of Italian gatherings formed a reference point for the collection, each design, says Navone, “has its own identity, and features the hint of imperfection that belongs to handmade items.” The top of the Murano glass Trevi Cocktail table, for example, features a corrugated texture that recalls the surface of the water in its namesake Roman fountain.

A sense of elegance and simplicity define Navone’s work, and while she states travel and staying curious are as important as breathing to her, she doesn’t have to go far to gain inspiration. “A simple trip to the market can reveal small wonders,” she says. “The value is knowing how to spot them.”

"Versatility is at the heart of my collections for **Ann Sacks**," says McGee. "There was a seamless cohesion between our brands and the way we wanted the finished product to look and feel in the context of a home."

Author, designer, and star of the beloved, Emmy-nominated Netflix show, *Dream Home Makeover*, Shea McGee has built a career out of making life beautiful. As the co-founder and the creative force behind the multifaceted design house Studio McGee, she's become a household name by empowering her millions of fans with the knowledge that luxury design can be accessible. In her latest venture, McGee designed three versatile tile collections for Ann Sacks. "I've used Ann Sacks in some capacity in nearly every home I've designed," she says. "They're experts in their field and they're just as excited about the nuances of textures and materials as I am." To start, McGee worked alongside the Ann Sacks' design team to identify gaps within their product assortment where she felt she could provide the Studio McGee aesthetic and vision. What resulted is three distinctive collections that exude livable luxury. Canyon Lake, a zellige-inspired tile that blends the tactility and movement of old-world tiles with the durability necessary for everyday living, features subtle variations and an alluring color palette that references nature. Willow Heights, meanwhile, consists of two marble mosaics influenced by the parquet flooring style, Brynn and Rylee. Lastly, Novah is a beautifully executed porcelain tile designed to illustrate the variances of limestone—slightly distressed edges add to its charm. "I give my all to the things I choose to spend my time on," says McGee. "Approaching everything you do with a sense of curiosity means you're always learning and that will naturally be reflected in what you're producing."

"For longevity," says McGee, "I think it's best to embrace a color palette that can be found in elements of nature."

Saving SONOMA

IN THIS EXPANSIVE WINE COUNTRY HOME, YOU CAN FEEL NATURE'S PULL FROM EVERY ROOM. BUT A SURPRISE ENCOUNTER WITH MOTHER NATURE ALSO CAME CLOSE TO SCUTTILING ITS CREATION.

Many aspects of this home's creation were memorable, says Katie McCaffrey, owner and principal of McCaffrey Design Group. For example, she says the homeowners—a couple looking to embrace retirement in a bespoke wine country house—took risks. They explored contemporary art collecting. And they eschewed what she calls a “typical” Sonoma neutral palette. But at a key point in construction, the project faced a risk that was significantly less aesthetic: wildfires.

“The fire was terrifying because it came so close to the site right in the stage of building when the framing was all exposed, raw wood. One ember would have ignited everything,” recalls McCaffrey. “I had just enough time to get within a block of the site before the police started turning us around and evacuating the neighborhood,” she says. “Thankfully, fire crews did an incredible job of saving Sonoma.”

Fortunately, the fire did not prevent McCaffrey Design Group—along with Bevan & Associates Architecture, Landers Curry Construction, and Rozanski & Associates Landscape Design—from crafting a home that embraces the outdoors and boasts space for entertaining and the homeowners' passion for Ping-Pong.

An open-concept main floor offers ample welcome to the table. “We wanted the dining space to be a welcoming focal point, but it also had to get along with all the other elements in the open kitchen and living room,” says McCaffrey. “I love Klismos chairs for their unstuffy and timeless elegance and keeping an airy feel.”

Choosing accent colors and textures from nature also helped unify the space. These include soft driftwood stains and vivid blues like those of the kitchen counter and sofa pillows. She also points to how the finish of the Formations pendants ties into the patina of the custom stove hood to keep the space from feeling “too modern.”

However, modernity was very much the goal when it came to

choosing art. “When we first signed on, the clients had mostly a collection of ‘plein air’ oil paintings,” she says. They expressed a desire to move into contemporary art. “We go to Art Basel Miami each year, and so we invited our clients to join us to do some art shopping. Most of the contemporary art in the home was purchased in one single trip!” The resulting collection includes Chuck Close, Damien Hirst, Roy Lichtenstein, and others.

Even with this bounty indoors, McCaffrey and company knew the outdoors would maintain a pull through the home’s many windows. On the east side facing the pool, George Bevan included a bank of massive folding doors, which allows the wall to open to the outdoors completely. So, McCaffrey limited


McCaffrey notes that the outdoors seems to have a gravitational pull. In the expansive poolside entertaining area, the lounges sport custom pillows covered in **Quadrielle's** Nairobi Suncloth in Navy on White. Meanwhile, white outdoor Zig-Zag tables are from **Serena & Lily** through **John Rosselli & Associates**. Other accent pillows are of custom **Perennials** fabrics, through **David Sutherland**.





"We wanted a bit more of a nod to the agrarian surroundings of Sonoma," McCaffrey explains, about how she conceived the design for the barn, "without following any of the typical modern farmhouse cliches." Their primary goal was to allow for space and "to not overpack the room with furnishings and just allow for fun things to happen."





"Rozanski and Associates did a marvelous job with all of the landscaping, but this garden is the icing on the cake," says McCaffrey. "The goal was to give the wife a place to allow her green thumb to shine." Veggies, herbs, flowers, and fruit trees are all planted here.

the furnishings there, as well. "This makes the two spaces meld into what feels like one giant entertainment space, which blurs the boundaries between indoors and out."

Also waiting outdoors? More indoors—specifically a barn that has its own kitchen, bedroom, powder room and plenty of space for Ping-Pong practice. (In his spare time, the husband plays competitively.) "The homeowners really wanted the barn to feel different from the house," explains McCaffrey. The kitchen's rich color stands out even under massive ceilings. Meanwhile, the lady of the house gets some outdoor space nearby, as well, with a beautiful garden that will see her tending to flowers, herbs, vegetables, and even her own fruit trees.

Ultimately, McCaffrey attributes the success of the project to the homeowners' confidence. "They placed full trust in us, the builders, and the architect. The result was an incredibly joyful, positive dynamic that permeated the entire build," she says. And it may be all the sweeter due to the endeavor's early brush with danger. "To see this project pull through and the clients happily moved in and enjoying the home is like a fairy-tale ending for me." ■



PLOT TWIST

SEARL LAMASTER HOWE CREATES A SPACIOUS HOME IN CHICAGO
FOR A LONGTIME CLIENT, EMBRACING LIFE CHANGES
AND MILESTONES ALONG THE WAY.




Since Searl Lamaster Howe designed this Chicago residence during the height of the pandemic, outdoor entertaining was non-negotiable. While the spacious living area offers plenty of space, the firm expanded the windows into doors that open onto the terrace. According to Howe, the client wanted to see the sweeping Lake Michigan views from the moment he stepped into his home. To do so, the Searl Lamaster Howe team kept entryway decor to a minimum, with ceiling sconces and a practical, pared-back bench.

Change is inevitable, but the trust of a good designer should endure life's litany of milestones—just ask Searl Lamaster Howe (SLH). Over a decade ago, the Chicago-based architecture and design firm was introduced to a newly single client who was moving back to the city and wanted to spruce up his new apartment. Fast forward to 2019, when the same client tapped the firm for a new project: merging two city units into one 4,000-square-foot apartment.

Though the SLH team understood the client's design preferences at a cellular level—and could deftly bring his “effortlessly upscale” vision to life—the task was by no means easy. “It was tricky because of where the pipes were located,” explains principal architect Greg Howe, who worked on the project alongside his colleague Ron Dapsis. “The smaller bedrooms and living rooms really prompted some distinctions with the design.” The team leaned into the challenge of change by covering the home's bones in a series of screen-like partitions to showcase the generous footprint. Speaking of the floor plan, the architects divvied up the supersize residence into private and public spaces.

“The two are treated like wings,” notes Bethany Grachan, one of SLH's interior designers, who spearheaded the residence's decor with Pam Lamaster-Millett. “You have your entertaining

wing side and a bit more privacy by the bedrooms toward the north side. We had sliding doors that could be opened or closed to create privacy or openness in those areas.”

With easy access to a terrace that overlooks Lake Michigan, the team designed the open-concept great room with the vista in mind. Guests can easily enjoy the view from a bevy of vantage points, be it the living room’s low-slung furniture, which is upholstered in David Sutherland and Kravet, or the custom banquette in the dining area. The concealed lights keep obstruction to a minimum, while the concrete detailing around the windows creates a warm glow from Lake Shore Drive.

When it came to designing the apartment’s private quarters, Howe says the team wanted to “keep a certain consistency in spirit, but also add some variety.” The mix of white oak and walnut in the bedrooms honor the home’s natural materials, while a Romo-upholstered bench and Waterworks fittings in the primary suite bring personality to these personal spaces. “He

lives a very informal life, but still has a level of refinement,” Howe says. “There’s a balancing act between the two.”

However, by the time the residence was completed in 2021, SLH was no longer working on a bachelor pad: he got engaged, married, and welcomed a new baby. Though a bundle of joy created some changes in the overall space—specifically, where to put the bassinet—Howe says the scope of the project stayed on track. “It’s a pretty adaptable space to a mix of lifestyles,” he notes. “That’s what every good project really should be because people’s needs change.”

The new family has embraced change once again by buying two properties: a residence in the suburbs and a lake house in Wisconsin, both designed by Searl Lamaster Howe. “We now had another person and then yet another person to factor into the project,” Grachan shares. “They all had very different starting points.” It’s a new challenge, but as this partnership continues to prove, change can be a great thing. ■




