

SRK first Indian to win Pardo Alla Carriera award @Locarno film fest

Exuding charm and being his witty self at the 2024 Locarno International Film Festival in Switzerland, actor Shah Rukh Khan was awarded the prestigious Pardo alla Carriera Ascona-Locarno Tourism aka the Career Leopard. He has been honoured with this award in recognition of his significant contributions to Indian

cinema. The 58-year-old is the first Indian celebrity to receive this award. During his acceptance speech, which took place at a packed Piazza Grande square in Locarno, on Saturday evening, Khan said, "I want to thank you all for welcoming me with such wide arms, wider than the ones I do on screen, to this really pretty,

very beautiful, cultural, artistic, and extremely hot city of Locarno. So many people stuffed up in a little square and so hot, it's just like being at home in India." As he lifted the trophy, he admitted he can't pronounce its name, but added: "The food has been nice, my Italian is improving and so has been my cooking. I can cook pasta and

pizza." When the host told him the proper pronunciation, Khan joked, "Which in English means the Leopard Award for being the most awesome in the world and the history of mankind." He wrapped his speech with "Namaskar. Dhanyawaad. God bless you all". The festival screened his 2002 film *Devdas*, directed by Sanjay Leela Bhansali. PTI

The Indian Men's Hockey Team players were driven to upgrade the colour of their medal at the Paris 2024 Olympics. But their second consecutive Bronze didn't deter their spirit to pay tribute to "big brother" PR Sreejesh, who announced his retirement from the sport. Back in India now, captain Harmanpreet Singh and some of his comrades, speak exclusively to HT City. "Medal ceremony pe jane se pehle saari hockey team Neeraj (Chopra; javelin thrower) bhai ka match dekh rahi thi," recalls Harmanpreet, whose podium gesture of exchanging his medal with the outgoing goalkeeper won hearts. "Last time bhi humne same cheez ki thi. He's like my big brother. Unke liye hum gold jeetna chahte thay, par woh pura nahi hua. But we are happy that for his last

match, we finished with a medal," adds Harmanpreet, fondly referred to as "Sarpanch" by not just his team but even PM Narendra Modi! Sreejesh is still in Paris as he was to be the joint flag-bearer alongside shooter Manu Bhaker at the Olympics closing ceremony. "The players are full of gratitude for their family, who've been their pillar of strength during this arduous journey. "My daughter, hockey ko jab bhi dekhti hai, hockey nahi bolti; woh papa bolti hai (smiles)," shares the flicker Harmanpreet, while defender Jarnmanpreet Singh shares a similar sentiment as a father of a tiny tot: "Meri bachhi (Jind Kaur), jab born hui thi, mera naam team mein aaya tha. Woh yahan hai, aur mera Olympic medal aa gaya hai." Most of the players feel the quarter-final match against Great Britain tested their limits. "Mere dimag mein yeh aaya ki abhi jeet ke hi nikalna hai, chahe jo ho jaye," shares Jarnmanpreet, while forward player Gurjant Singh adds, "Woh match mein hum sab ka mindset yeh tha ki bahut time se humne is tournament ka wait kiya hai aur humein jeetna hai... Though we were just nine players on the ground!" It was this do or die spirit and the cheering of Indian fans "who held the Tiranga" in the audience, which boosted the morale of these men in blue. Recalling it, forward player Sukhjeet Singh feels glad he could bag a medal in his Olympics debut, and says, "Jab podium par naam announce hua toh mujhe sabse pehle khayal meri country aur meri family ka aaya."

He quips, "She acts as my bodyguard when go out in public." Sharing an incident where he turned saviour for his sister, Karan says, "I was on a movie date when Sasha called. She got into a brawl with a girl who punctured her car's tyres and wanted to take her to the police. I reached to chaos with two girls fighting in the middle of the streets of Mumbai. It was a very hilarious and filmy scene."

SAVOUR THE ROYAL FLAVOURS OF MUTTON PASANDA

Mutton Pasanda dates back to the 16th century and became a staple at the courts of Mughal Emperors of Turco-Mongol origin who ruled India under a Muslim Persianate dynasty. In Urdu, the word pasanda means "favourite" and is prepared with the finest cuts of juiciness meat. Today, the Mutton Pasanda recipe is a wonderful example of the syncretic Ganga-Jamni culture of the Kayasthas of Shahjahanabad. Traditionally, the meat is slow-cooked to enhance its tenderness and infused with flavours from ingredients like cardamom, cloves and cinnamon. Savour this royal dish by ordering the juiciest boneless mutton cuts from Zappfresh.

THE REGAL RECIPE

Marinate 500g of thinly sliced boneless mutton with 2 cups of yogurt, 2tbsp ginger-garlic paste, 1tsp each of turmeric, red chilli, garam masala, coriander, cumin powder and salt to taste. Refrigerate for at least 2 hours or overnight. Heat 1/4 cup ghee or oil in a heavy-bottomed pan or pressure cooker, fry 2 sliced onions until golden brown, then add the marinated mutton and cook for 10-12 minutes until browned. Add enough water to cover the meat, cover, and cook until tender (30-40 minutes in a pan or 10-12 minutes in a pressure cooker). Stir in 1/2 cup fresh cream, simmer for 2-3 minutes until the gravy thickens, garnish with 2tbsp chopped coriander leaves, and serve hot.





Chefs tell us how they are serving up their hot chocolate this monsoon... And how you can raise your game, too



SOME LIKE IT HOT: IT'S RAINING CHOCOLATE



This S'more Nutella hot chocolate can be found at Lupa in Bengaluru

"You, too, can transform this classic beverage to an exciting adventure by spiking it with a splash of alcohol," says Mahesh Pal Singh, head chocolatier at Smoor. He suggests Bailey's Irish cream for caramel sweetness, whiskey for warming depth, and brandy and honey to create a harmonious combination. At Delhi's EVOO Eatery & Pizzeria, founder Sachin Grover's velvety rich cioccolata calda (Italian

for hot chocolate) is made with real dark Belgian chocolate and milk. He says, "We top it with toasted marshmallows for the perfect cup." On the other hand, LUPA in Bengaluru has rolled out a special hot chocolate cart as an "exciting little addition" to enjoy the city's perfect sweater weather. "Our live station is doling out cup after cup with a few variations. We have flavours like Nutella, Baileys and even an orange and cinnamon combination," says chef Manu Chandra. The hot chocolate menu at Mumbai's Toast Doughnut Shop has several wacky

MAKE IT HEALTHY

If you want to make it healthy, chef Aathira Sethumadhavan believes you can still enjoy hot cocoa if you are on a fitness journey. "I make an anti-inflammatory version that is good for building immunity, free of refined sugar and cornflour, without compromising on taste," she says. Simmer almond milk with a cinnamon stick, a pinch of turmeric and pepper powder. Blend it with pitted dates and cashews, unsweetened cocoa powder, melted dark chocolate and a dash of coconut cream for thickening.


HOT CHOCOLATE AT HOME

Want to make your own hot cuppa chocolate? Nikhil Jain, founder of Coppetto Artisan Gelato, has some tips: "Use high-quality chocolate for richer flavour. Always opt for the double boiler technique, which melts the chocolate gently and lets it be glossy. Gradually add fresh cream and whole milk to the melted chocolate, stirring constantly to avoid clumping or spitting. Using a milk frother adds a lovely texture. And remember, you might like it thick, but it needs to be drinkable."

Other additions that can make for a delicious cuppa are mixing in pieces of brownie, red velvet cake or even chocolate biscuits. You could also try swapping in white chocolate chips instead of the dark, swirling in some dulce de leche or adding in vanilla and almond extract for a flavoursome cup of cocoa.



Quinoa for diabetes? Here's how to eat it



DIABETIC-FRIENDLY WAY
It is essential to keep added sugars and unhealthy fats to a minimum while incorporating other nutritious ingredients that help manage blood sugar levels, says Goyal. Basic quinoa preparation involves rinsing one cup of quinoa under cold water. You can boil this rinsed quinoa with two cups of water or low-sodium vegetable broth for added flavour. Other ways to consume quinoa for diabetes would be as part of a salad. Cooked quinoa can be combined with fresh vegetables, chopped leafy greens such as spinach or kale, chopped nuts or seeds such as almonds, walnuts, sunflower seeds, and some olive oil. Or, go for a quinoa and vegetable stir-fry.

HOW MUCH QUINOA TO EAT IN A DAY AS A DIABETIC?
Portion control is crucial to manage blood sugar levels effectively. "A general recommendation is about 1/2 to one cup of cooked quinoa per meal. This amount provides close to 20-40g of carbs, which can fit into a balanced meal plan for diabetes management," says Goyal. For more such stories, visit healthshots.com



What the neck! 'Headless' Olympian's photo goes viral










