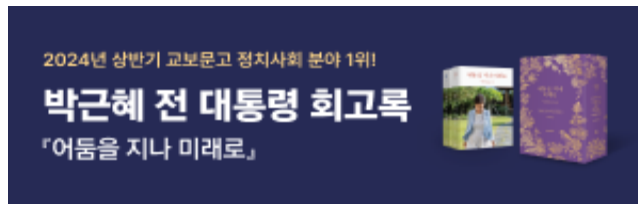

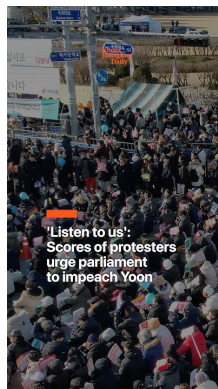

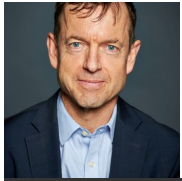


To break the cycle, change the system

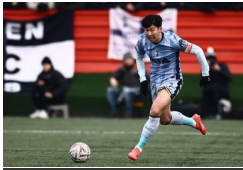
