





The painting will be offered at Sotheby's London Modern & Contemporary Evening Auction.

Hoppus hopes the sale will support emerging artists. "I want to be a punk rock Medici," he said, referencing the Renaissance-era patrons of the arts.



#### 'NEW GENERATIONS HAVE NEW **CHALLENGES - BUT ALSO OPPORTUNITIES'**


our country - army, naval or air force, because they work day and night, and it is because of them that we are free to live in an independent and democratic country.

# It was a minor overdose caused by stress: Kalpana's daughter clarifies

#### What happened?

Kalpana was found unconscious in her Hyderabad residence on Tuesday after authorities forced entry into her apartment following concerns raised by her husband, Prabhakar Prasad, who was in Chennai at the time. Reportedly, he became worried when she didn't answer his calls and alerted the association. The apartment's security team was informed, prompting neighbours to contact the police. Apparently, Kalpana had returned to Hyderabad from Kerala earlier that morning. She was immediately rushed to a hospital, where medical professionals are closely monitoring her condition.

#### **Medical update**



Doctors treating Kalpana stated that she was brought in around 5:30 pm in a drowsy state. "We had information that she consumed sleeping pills in a large quantity. A stomach wash was performed immediately. She developed breathing difficulties, and we conducted a CT scan and brain scan. Stress-induced

pulmonary edema was also detected, which led to her being placed on ventilator support. As of today, she has been removed from the ventilator and is conscious."

#### **Celebrities show support**

News of her hospitalisation has shaken the music fraternity, with playback singers Sunitha, Sri Krishna, and Karunya among those visiting her at the hospital. A playback singer with over 1,500 songs to her name, Kalpana is the daughter of composer TS Raghavendra. She rose to fame after winning Star Singer Malayalam in 2010 and later gained recognition as a judge on various music reality shows, including Bigg Boss Telugu Season 1. Throughout her career, she has worked with prominent figures like Ilaiyaraaja and AR Rahman.



#### 'This was not a suicide attempt'






