



SNOWBALL - WEEKLY FINANCIAL MARKETS UPDATES MARCH 14TH, 2025

INDIA

- Sensex (75,311) & Nifty (22,796): Ended lower by 0.50%, marking the fourth consecutive losing session and hitting 8-month lows.
- Rupee Strengthens: Gains for the third straight day; forex reserves surge by \$15 billion.
- India's GDP Outlook: Moody's forecasts over 6.5% growth in FY26.
- **Retail Inflation:** Falls to 3.61% in February 2025, a 7-month low.
- **US Tariffs on Steel & Aluminium:** MSMEs likely to be impacted; India's steel industry downplays major effects.
- SEBI Tightens SME IPO Norms: Stricter regulations to protect investors.
- **RBI Investigates Derivatives Exposure:** Reviewing banks' books after IndusInd-related concerns.
- Starlink Expands in India: Partnerships with Jio & Airtel to boost satellite broadband.
- Healthcare Costs Rise: Policyholders increasingly relying on loans to retain coverage.
- Al & Automation in BPOs: Hiring slowdown as routine tasks get automated.
- LG India's ₹15,000 Cr IPO: SEBI approval granted.
- EU Investors: Showing fresh interest in Indian equities (Macquarie report).
- Quick Commerce Surge: Now accounts for 70–75% of e-grocery orders, up from 35% in 2022.
- Real Estate Boom: Developers acquired ₹39,700 crore worth of land in 2024 (JLL).
- Commercial Vehicles: Expected 3-5% growth in FY26 (ICRA).

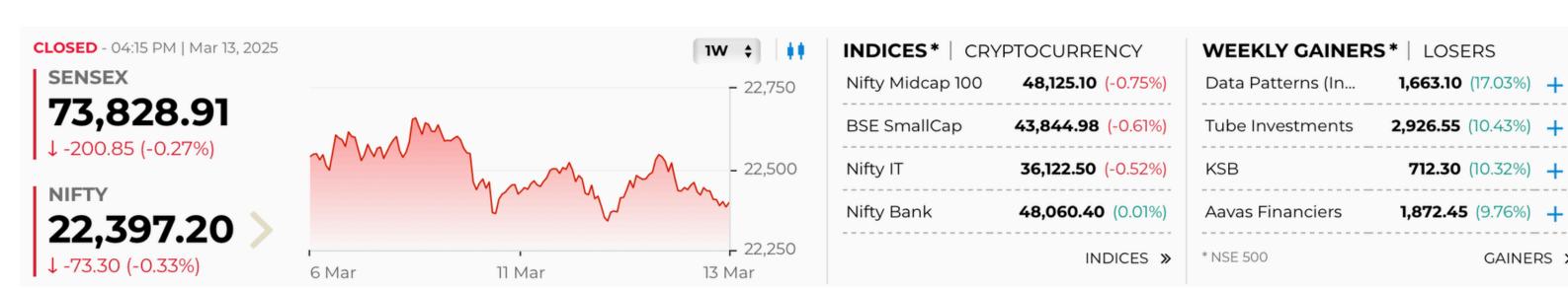
