Visit to 'Old Age Home' by the Department of History



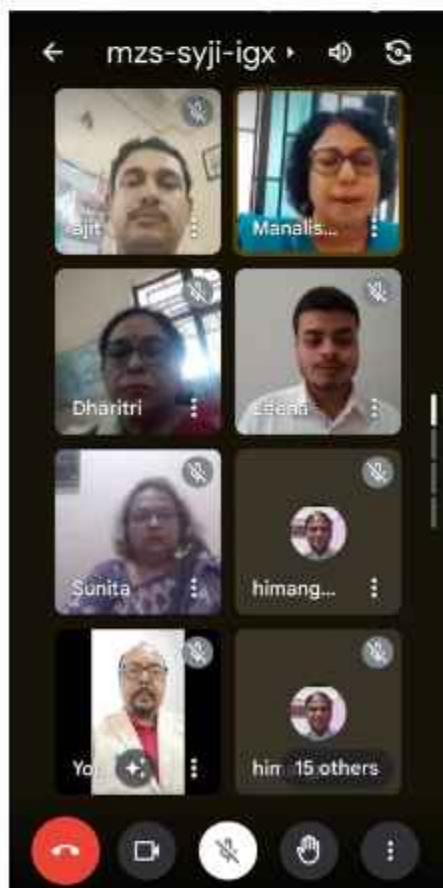
